Membership in the musical life of the house

Not everyone who belongs in this room comes for lessons. Some come to sing badly and happily among friends. Some come to listen. Some bring children who are not yet ready for a teacher, but are entirely ready for music.

The Salon Society is our answer — a way to join the evenings, the salons and the social-music nights at Maison Gruba without enrolling in weekly study.

ALREADY ENROLLED?

This is already yours.

Every Maison Gruba student is a member of the Salon Society by virtue of enrollment. Salons, social-music evenings and seasonal gatherings are included in your monthly tuition — no dues, no registration, nothing further to pay.

And you need not come alone. On evenings marked Open Salon on the calendar, each enrolled household may bring up to two guests as our complimentary guests. Bring the neighbour who claims she cannot sing. She is exactly who we mean.

What follows is for everyone else — the friends, families and neighbours who would like a seat in the room on their own terms.

MEMBERSHIP

Three Ways to Belong

Each is month-to-month. No semester prepayment, no contract, no obligation beyond the month you are in — the same terms we offer every family who studies here.

FOR ADULTS

Salon Membership

Adults, eighteen and above

\$55 / month

or \$550 annually
month-to-month, cancel any time

Twenty-four seats held

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- Evening salons — live music, conversation that runs late
 - Social-music evenings — the piano is open, and so is the microphone
 - Adult workshops: listening sessions, poetry evenings, song-history talks
 - Standing invitation to student recitals as an audience member

FOR TEENS

Young Artist Membership

Ages thirteen to seventeen

\$45 / month

or \$450 annually
parent or guardian countersigns

Sixteen seats held

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- Open-mic and showcase evenings among peers who take music seriously
 - Observation seats at masterclasses and audition-preparation sessions
 - Songwriting and collaboration circles, faculty-hosted
 - A first stage that is warm rather than competitive

FOR FAMILIES

Family Membership

Children four to twelve, with up to two adults

\$75 / month

per household · or \$750 annually
siblings included, no per-child charge

Twelve households held

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- Family music mornings — singing, rhythm, movement, instruments to touch
 - Story-and-song hours pairing poetry with live piano
 - Seasonal family salons and holiday sing-alongs
 - A gentle first encounter with the studio, long before a first lesson

Joining, Visiting, Belonging

BEFORE YOU JOIN

Come for a single evening

You are welcome to visit once as a guest before deciding anything. A single evening is \$40 for an adult, \$25 for a teen, or \$60 for a family. Should you join the Society within thirty days, that amount is applied in full toward your first month.

EARLY ENROLLMENT GIFT

The registration is our gift

Society membership carries a one-time registration of \$50 per household. For anyone joining on or before 31 August 2026, we are waiving it entirely — the same gift we extend to families enrolling for the autumn.

A word about what this is

The Salon Society is company, not curriculum. Our evenings are gatherings — you will be welcomed, accompanied and applauded, but you will not be taught. Instruction, coaching and repertoire work belong to our enrolled students and their weekly hour.

The door between the two rooms is deliberately left open. Every Society member is welcome to a complimentary thirty-minute introductory lesson, whenever curiosity strikes — and should a member begin study with us, the annual membership fee is waived and the current month's dues are applied to the first month of tuition.

To join

- Write to studio@maisongruba.com and tell us which membership suits you — or simply ask which evening to come to first.
- We will send the season's calendar, hold your seat and confirm your start date.
- Dues begin the month you first attend. Nothing is charged before then.

TERMS IN BRIEF

So that nothing is a surprise

A summary only. Membership is governed by the Salon Society Membership Agreement, which each member signs at registration.

Dues and cancellation	Memberships are month-to-month. Dues are billed on the first of each month. You may cancel at any time by written notice before the next billing date. Dues already paid are not refunded or prorated, including for evenings you do not attend.
This is not instruction	Salon Society membership provides social participation only. No lesson, coaching, evaluation, credential or assessment is provided or implied, and membership is not enrollment in the studio's instructional programme.
Calendar	Evenings, hosts and programmes may change. Maison Gruba may reschedule, substitute or cancel any gathering. No credit is issued for a member's non-attendance.
Children and young members	A parent or guardian must remain present throughout every Family Membership gathering. Maison Gruba does not provide childcare or supervision. Young Artist memberships require a guardian signature.
Guests	Guests attend by invitation of a member or an enrolled household. The inviting party is responsible for their guests' conduct, and every guest signs a visitor acknowledgement on arrival.
The premises and the instruments	Gatherings are held in a working piano gallery containing instruments of considerable value. Members are responsible for damage or loss caused by themselves, their children or their guests.
Photography	Photography and recording may take place. Use of any image is governed by a separate media release that you sign, or decline, independently of membership.
Admission	Maison Gruba may decline admission or end a membership at any time where conduct warrants it, refunding unused dues.
